

Watch for Your Notice - Mailed in August!

Every August, Monitor Telecom processes the cooperative members capital credit allocations for the previous year and a notice is mailed to the members having service that year. (example notice displayed)



The dollar amount on your notice is your share of the profit and is placed on the Cooperative books. Each member's share is determined by their individual contributions to the revenue; by purchasing telephone and internet services. It is the Board of Directors responsibility to review the financial health of the company and decide when that equity can be paid back to the members. Save your allocation notice for your records. 

MCTC adopts this Open Internet Policy to promote the Internet as an open platform enabling customer choice, freedom of expression, end-user control, competition, and the freedom to innovate without permission.

No Unreasonable Discrimination

MCTC does not unreasonably discriminate in transmitting lawful network traffic over a customer's broadband Internet access service, subject to reasonable network management. Reasonable network management practices are set out below.

No Impairment or Delay; No Discrimination

MCTC DOES NOT:

- Discriminate among specific uses, or class of uses, of its network
- Impair, degrade or delay VoIP applications or services that compete with its voice services or those of its affiliates
- Impair, degrade, delay or otherwise inhibit access by customers to lawful content, applications, services or non-harmful devices
- Impair free expression by actions such as slowing traffic from particular web sites or blogs
- Demand pay-for-priority or similar arrangements that directly or indirectly favor some traffic over other traffic
- Prioritize its own application, services or devices or those of its affiliates

No Blocking

MCTC does not block lawful content, applications, services, or non-harmful devices, subject to reasonable network management. Network management practices are set forth below.

Use of Network

In no case will MCTC discriminate among customers on the basis of the type of content, applications, services or devices which the customer uses.

Access Recovery Charge (ARC)

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) proposed a decrease on the Access Recovery Charge (ARC) from \$2.89 to \$0.89 per month on residential lines and was effective July 1, 2018 on Monitor Telecom customers' statements. The ARC is designed to recover increased network costs for the access circuits used to provide service to customers, 2449
