Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands.

TWO STEPS TO ENROLL

- 1. Go to AffordableConnectivity.gov to submit an application or print a mail-in app
- 2. Contact Monitor Telecom to select an eligible plan, and complete an ACP consent form

Eligible households can enroll directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) online at http://acpbenefit.org/. You can learn more about the benefit, including eligibility and enrollment information, by visiting www.fcc.gov/ACP, or by calling 1-877-384-2575.

Cybersecurity Awareness

Social Engineering Attacks - What Is It?

Social engineering attacks are schemes used by scammers who rely on deception and psychological manipulation on victims to hand over sensitive information. The word "social" refers to the human piece of this attack and relies on human interaction. It is another way to trick a trusting person into freely divulging information or gain access to a system to exploit and steal.

3 Types of Social Engineering Attacks

1. Phishing ("fishing")

This attack involves receiving emails claiming to be from a reputable or trusted company in order to obtain personal/sensitive information such as payment card details, and passwords. They are NOT legitimate!



- Phishing remains to be the top threat used by cybercriminals
- Phishing emails may contain an urgent request for help
- Never click on links or download attachments from suspicious looking email
- Verify suspicious emails through another communication channel
- Be an email superhero Don't Get Reeled In

2. Pretexting

This attack involves receiving phone calls from an impersonator claiming to be from a trusted entity in order to obtain sensitive information for financial gain and/or to acquire remote access into the victim's computer. The scam caller may claim they are with a banking institution, law enforcement, IRS agent or computer specialist, etc.



- Pretexting is the creation of a convincing, believable "scenario"
- Fraudsters want to gain your trust by presenting themselves as friendly, helpful and using a pleasant voice
- Scammers may know your name, address or email address to deceive you
- Scare tactics may be used telling you to act quickly
- Don't be fooled

3. Baiting

This attack involves luring a victim into a trap by promising them something valuable such as, free music downloads, online promotions or to participate in an online contest. The main goal is to retrieve vital information or get access to a computer. These scams rely on influencing one's curiosity, fear, or greed to bait the trap – like a piece of cheese in a mousetrap!

- Baiting comes in the form of Pop-up ads or online promotions
- It is highly manipulative
- Promises great discounts or free stuff
- Thrives on tempting offers usually difficult to resist
- Don't take the bait!

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SOCIAL ENGINEERING!!

- 1. Stay Alert learn to think skeptically
- 2. Install antivirus and anti-malware software to detect malicious activity
- 3. Install pop-up blockers
- 4. Limit what you share on social media this makes it harder for hackers to target you
- 5. Never share sensitive information over the phone, email, or text

Create longer, complex passwords that cannot be guessed by others.
