Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands.

TWO STEPS TO ENROLL

- 1. Go to AffordableConnectivity.gov to submit an application or print a mail-in app
- 2. Contact Monitor Telecom to select an eligible plan, and complete an ACP consent form

Eligible households can enroll directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) online at http://acpbenefit.org/. You can learn more about the benefit, including eligibility and enrollment information, by visiting www.fcc.gov/ACP, or by calling 1-877-384-2575.

Watch out for Social Security scams

If you receive a call, text, or email that...

- Threatens to suspend your Social Security number, even if they have a part or all of your SS#
- Warns of arrest of legal action
- Demands or requests immediate payment
- Requires payment by gift card, prepaid debit car, internet currency, or by mailing cash
- Pressures you for personal information
- · Requests secrecy
- Threatens to seize your bank acc
- Promises to increase your Social Security benefits
- Tries to gain your trust by providing fake "documentation", "false evidence" or the name of a real government official

...It is a SCAM!

The Social Security Administration will NEVER threaten, scare, or pressure you to take an immediate action!

Protect yourself and others from Social Security - related scams

- 1. Stay Calm Do not provide anyone with money or personal information when you feel pressured, threatened, or scared.
- 2. Hang up or ignore it Do not respond to suspicious calls, texts, or emails

- 5. Spread the word share with your friends and family to be alert during tax season!



2023 FRS Youth Tour

Experience Your Nation's Capital!

Monitor Telecom will be sponsoring one local high school student to experience our nation's capital this summer. Hosted by the Foundation for Rural Services (FRS), this unique 5-day excursion, brings more than 100 high school students from rural communities across the nation, to get an inside perspective on the telecommunication industry, learn the legislative processes and the importance of quality broadband connections. Students will meet with FCC and congressional staff, as well as tour many famous historical sites and monuments. The trip is scheduled from May 31 to June 4, 2023.

To be eligible, applicants must be a high school student living in the Monitor exchange, with active service, and must be 15, 16 or 17 years of age at the time of the tour. FRS will not accept any student 18 years of age or over – no exceptions will be made. Students must submit a 500 word essay on "How Broadband Improves Our Rural Community." Finalists will then be scheduled for an interview with the Monitor Telecom Board of Directors. The winner will be notified by the Company.

Fee Changes

FUSC – Federal Universal Service Charge Effective January 1, 2023, the rate increased from 28.9% to 32.6%. The FUSC is a federally mandated fee by the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) that is designed to keep local telephone service rates affordable to all Americans, regardless of where they live.

Late Fee

Effective January 1, 2023, the late fee on past due balances increased from 2.1% to 2.2%. This fee is charges against any unpaid balance remaining at the time of the next billing cycle.

Deposit Interest Rate

Effective January 1, 2023, the annual interest rate for customer deposits increased from 0.1% to 4.5%.
